

This is a lovely addition to the Madeline group of books. As all those following the original, it begins with the typical "In an old house it Paris all covered with vines. . .", but then begins a new adventure. This one introduces Pepito in which he tries to ruin the darling tea party hosted by Madeline. Sweet story and musical rhymes, as usual. It is not a hard cover book like many others; it is the less expensive paper version, but the price reflects it.
