

J'avais cru que ce n'était pas possible de traduire Dr. Seuss en franÃf§ais. Pourtant

Anne-Laure Fournier le Ray a réussi à traduire à « Green Eggs and Ham à » sans perdant ni rythme ni rime caractéristique de Dr. Seuss et en laissant intacte le sens et contexte de cette oeuvre. à « Ce Sam-c'est moi à » est toujours le mÃfªme : déterminé et inébranlable en face de son adversaire grincheux qui refuse implacablement les délices culinaires verts avec un déluge de phrases négatives telles que à « Je n'en veux pas, ni ici, ni lÃ. / Je n'en veux pas aucun endroit. »Je dois admettre que les premià res fois que je l'ai lu je devais m'accoutumer aux petits différences entre cette traduction et la version originelle. Par exemple, au lieu de à « I do not like green eggs and ham./ I do not like them, Sam-I-am à » on dit à « Je n'aime pas les oeufs verts au jambon. Et quand je dis non, c'est non. A » Un peu différent oui, mais  $\tilde{A}$  galement satisfaisant pour les tout-petits qui se r $\tilde{A}$  jouiront d' $\tilde{A}$  couter mille fa $\tilde{A}f$  sons de dire à « Je n'en mangerai pas ! à » Les grandes personnes prendront plaisir à lire ce livre aussi.\*\*\*\*\*\*I didn't think it was possible to translate Dr. Seuss into french. However Anne-Laure Fournier Le Ray was able to translate "Green Eggs and Ham" without losing the rhythm or rhyme characteristic of Dr. Seuss and leaving the meaning and context of this work intact. "Sam-c'est moi" is the same as ever: determined and unshakeable in the face of his grumpy opponent who relentlessly refuses the green culinary delights with a flood of negative phrases such as "Je n'en veux pas, ni ici, ni IÃ. / Je n'en veux pas à aucun endroit." I must admit that the first few times I read it I had to get used to the small differences between this translation and the original version. For example, instead of "I do not like green eggs and ham. / I do not like them, Sam-I-am" it reads "Je n'aime pas les oeufs verts au jambon. Et quand je dis non, c'est non. " A little different yes, but equally satisfying for toddlers who will love to listen to a thousand ways to say "I won't eat it!" Grownups will enjoy reading this book too.

We already have "green eggs and ham" and now i am able to read this to my son in french and daady reads it in english. My son loves it and improved his vocabulary with a few new french words.

This is not an exact translation but it is very close. What I like is that the verse has the rhythm of the original book. The printing and paper is also very good quality.

This was my children's favorite book when they were little and now that they are older taking a foreign language in school, it brings back fun memories and is an enjoyable way to practice fluency and pronunciation.

I love exposing my almost-two-year-old to French, and this book is such a fun way to do it. If I were a French teacher, I'd have all my students read this aloud to help them with enunciation and rhythm. I absolutely love it, and my little girl seems to too. The translation is almost flawless -- I'm no expert, but I caught a few mistakes. But taking Dr. Seuss's brilliance into another language without sacrificing the rhyme and the meter should have been impossible, but they've done it!

This is even more fun in French than it is in English, especially if you're reading it to a Frenchman and your accent is more Inspector Clouseau than true French. I bought it as a gift for my nephew, and he got a kick out of it, but the adults loved it even more.
