

I was looking for a companion to Susan Wise Bauer's "Story of the World" series to help expand our study of World War I. Not only is this a fantastic resource for projects, but the text will be a valuable addition to our reading. What a fantastic book!

This book series makes history interesting for children. It takes the horrors of war and puts it on a child's level, teaching them what happened in the war and why we had the war, and what happened to end the war.

A summary of the review on StrategyPage.Com:'Rasmussen, who has written or edited several books, including Mark Twain for Kids, gives us a very good, well-illustrated introductory work for young readers. He offers a credible outline history of the war in a dozen chapters. Chapters give an even-handed look at the origins of the war, campaigns on various fronts (albeit with the customary biases of English language works), the nature of war on land, at sea, and in the air, the role of animals, the Home Fronts, the U.S. and the War, the end of the conflict, and its consequences. Each chapter includes one or two hands-on activities, such as writing a poem, making a tube periscope or a parachute, cooking Macoochie stew, and even â ÂœSearch for a Convoyâ Â•. Rasmussen uses text, maps, side bars, pictures, and more to tell the story of the war, including the death and destruction.
