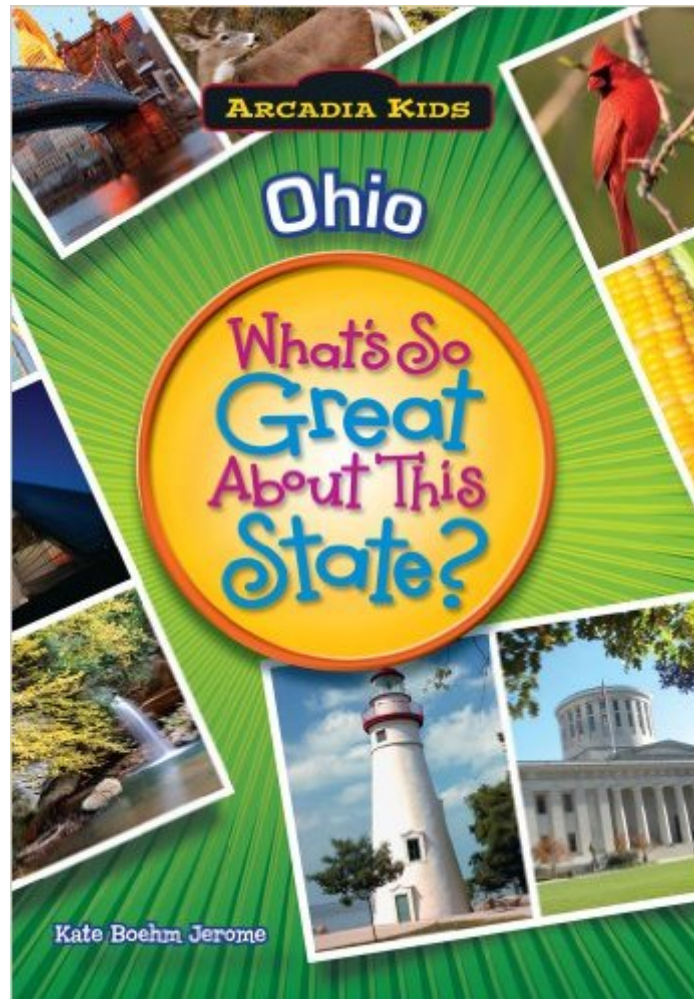

But on the other hand, the pictures are nicely done. I bought it for my son's Ohio History unit for his 4th grade year. I will definitely need to supplement the history portion, as this doesn't cover a lot and focuses more on the geography of the state, symbols and the flag, agriculture, landmarks, etc. Definitely an elementary age book.

I agree with another reviewer's comment about this book. Very little information. It's only about 20

pages and half of those are very nice pictures but it isn't nearly enough to do a state report on. Fortunately, I do have the internet and another book called *Weird Ohio* so that will help with the information.
