

Additionally, the book ends with a reference to her suicide. They are careful to point out that suicide was viewed as honorable back then, but they don't say that today it is not viewed the same way (and shouldn't be). It opened up a healthy conversation with my daughter, and that's OK, but I want other parents to know and be prepared.

I purchased this ffor my daughter's class project. I was looking for something that was light enough for her to carry and with just enough information on the subject. We have a much higher quality reference book on Egyptian history and culture in our home library, so this was just a short term solution. It served its purpose.
