

After trying all the tricks in the book, Little Penguin decides the next thing to try is to have you help him scare the hiccups away. Little does he know he is in for quite the surprise.This is a lovely, interactive book and children will love taking part in the story. Oh, and I hope that whoever is responsible for reading this book out loud has a good "fake hiccup" because you will be doing a lot of them throughout this one :)
