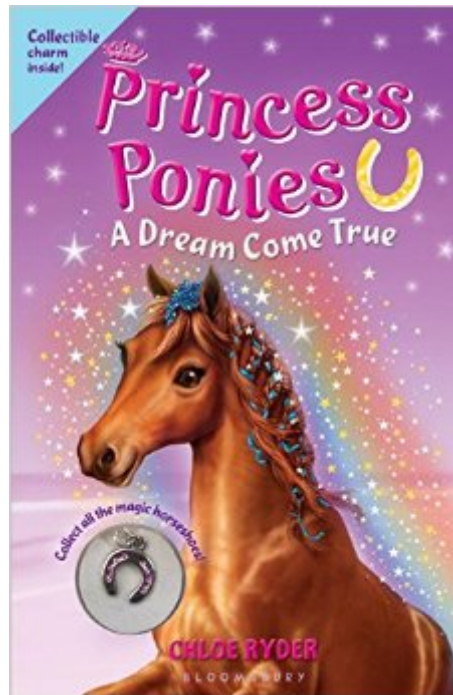

My 6-year-old daughter loved the first book in this series, and she begged me to get her #2. I did, and we finished this one in just a couple of days. I (dad) was bored out of my wits with the slow moving, very predictable and simplistic storyline. My daughter on the otherhand was enthralled, always begging to read "just a little more." She would give this 5 stars and is already begging for #3, which I've preordered. I am not sad that the third book isn't written yet so that I have a break from the Pony's of Chevalia. If you have not read #1 yet, you need to get the first book in the series before this. The stories really do not stand on their own. So far it really seems like this should just be a longer book and that they broke it up into a bunch of smaller books (each with a horseshoe charm) to con dads with young daughters out of more money. Good ploy...it worked. So I'm sure that we will

end up buying every book in the series. Honestly I have really enjoyed the time reading with my daughter.

In the past, my 8-year-old has not enjoyed reading. When I read this book with her, she didn't want to put it down. It's a well written adventure book with encouraging messages for young readers about bravery, teamwork and friendship. My daughter was able to make many text-to-self connections. For example, in the book Blossom's feelings get hurt because her best friend Stardust has found a new best friend in protagonist Pippa. They conclude that it is right to have many best friends and they end up working together as a team and relying on each other's strengths to find the missing horseshoe. As parents, we encourage our daughter to have many "best friends", so as not to act exclusive. She made that connection with the book. I would highly recommend this book!

This made a great little Easter gift, with a second charm for the charm bracelet that came with the first book. My seven-year-old niece loved it and sat right down on the sofa next to me to read it, and became completely absorbed. What could be better than ponies that are princesses? With a strong helpful human girl and nice line drawings. Moderately priced, too.

Actually, my granddaughter loved the book. I started a Book Club for my grandkids and every time they finish a book, we have a Face-Time book chat, then I send another book. My granddaughter's BFF is now an honorary member in the club and loved the book, too. They both wore the charm bracelet, that's included, on the last day of school.

Came in time for Christmas! She is really enjoying the story. The horse shoe charm was with it like it was supposed to. The story is about a magical island of horses. There are horse shoes missing and a great adventure to find them. Good book for young horse lovers!

A book by Chloe Ryder, *Princess Ponies 2: A Dream Come True* is a great book for young girls who love horses. It encouraged our 8 year old granddaughter to read and now she wants more of the books. Thanks, keep them coming.
